- Develop, implement, maintain, and monitor health and safety policies and procedures appropriate to our business activity.
- Provide the necessary resources to implement our policies and keep them up to date.
- Review and revise this policy statement on an annual basis.

We encourage the full and active participation of all our employees in order that the principles outlined in this policy statement may be achieved. The statutory duties placed on Harrison Preservation Limited and all our employees are to be regarded as minimum standards. We aim to achieve best practice in terms of health and safety in all that we do.
